

# AUTHORS SECTION

**Name.** This section is an alphabetical listing, by last name, of all of the known quotation authors or sources. Each person's complete name is provided, with the last name in **bold** type for easy reference.

**Lifetime.** Where known, each "author's" year of birth and, if applicable, year of death is shown. The exact dates of some ancient quotations are uncertain, so the approximate 'circa' year is indicated by "c.". If an author published under an alias, both names are cross-referenced—e.g., Samuel Langhorne Clemens & Mark Twain.

**Biography.** Where the author is known, a very brief bio is provided.

**Quote Numbers.** Finally, each author listing concludes with their referenced quote(s)—by quote number—that are attributed to them and can be found in the **QUOTES SECTION**.
